## **Introduction:**

### **Non-Discrimination Clause**

This organization shall adhere to the University of Denver's Policy of non-discrimination, which is as follows:

It is the policy of the University not to discriminate in the admission of students, in the provision of services, or in employment, on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, marital or veteran status, sexual orientation or disability status; and to take appropriate affirmative action in connection therewith.

#### **Section 1: Events**

Through our collaboration with the administration, LawHAWC provides yoga and meditation in the law school to encourage student mindfulness and provide accessible stress relief. We will also provide an art show and performance festival in the Spring semester in hopes of allowing students a means of artistic expression and the opportunity to share their work.
