

# 2016 PILG Clerkship Application Instructions

*Please review the following instructions prior to beginning the application process.*

**All required materials must be submitted by 11:59pm on April 13, 2016.**

**Description:** PILG Clerkships are awarded on a merit-basis to students who have secured otherwise-unpaid summer work in public interest. Clerkship recipients will be awarded a cash stipend of between \$1500-\$3000, depending on their specific needs.

**Qualifications:** You must be a current DU Law students in your first or second year. In order to be considered for funding, you must have secured a legal placement with a public interest organization or government agency. *(Examples of qualifying placements include, but are not limited to, non-profits, public defender's offices, federal offices, and international aid organizations).*

**Application:** To be considered for funding, you must submit the following:

- 3) **Your placement supervisor must send an email confirming your placement to [eoverall17@law.du.edu](mailto:eoverall17@law.du.edu).** This email must acknowledge your position over the summer and give a very brief description of the general type of work you will complete.

Note: If you wish to receive externship credit for your placement, you must still complete and submit all the necessary paperwork with the Sturm College of Law Externship Office.
