### Certification of Successful Completion of Upper Level & International Law Topic Writing Requirement

#### INSTRUCTIONS

In addition to the other mandatory course requirements of the International Law Certificate Program, students seeking a certificate in the specialty area of international or comparative law at the Sturm College of Law must complete a research paper in a topic relevant to international or comparative law and which also satisfies Sturm's Upper Level Writing requirement. The research paper requirement can be satisfied by a student writing a research paper for one of the International Law courses or seminars which also meets the upper-level writing requirement. It can also be satisfied by a student undertaking a directed research for 3 credit hours on an International Law topic with a full-time faculty member at Sturm. Such directed research product must also meet Sturm's upper-level writing requirement (students wishing to meet the paper requirement via participation in a directed research should direct their requests to Professor Ved P. Nanda, International Legal Studies Program Faculty Director).

Course instructors or faculty supervisors must certify, with this form and on behalf of the student, that the student has written a paper which covers an international or comparative law topic *and that* such paper meets the Upper Level Writing requirement.

This certification form must be completed, signed and returned to the Registrar's Office. Students will not be awarded the certificate until such form is completed and signed by a faculty member, and returned to the Registrar's office by the student. Please note, again, that students must also meet the other mandatory requirements of the program which includes submission of the on-line course certification form.
