### Why Do a Competency Model?

For faculty and staff: It helps us as educators articulate our learning goals for students, and it gives us a way to systemically review our curriculum to identify missing pieces

For students: It guides students in tracking their skills development and makes them more conscious about their professional development

For prospective students: It signals how a Santa Clara Law degree differs from the competition, and it provides them some sense of the skills they can expect to acquire as part of their degree

For employers: It communicates to prospective employers what they can expect from our graduates
