The University of Denver Sturm College of Law's Laura Rovner has been named to *5280 Magazine's* list of "Top Lawyers 2015." At Denver Law, she is the Ronald V. Yegge Clinical Director and Associate Professor of Law. Professor Rovner teaches in the Civil Rights Clinic, which represents clients in cases involving prisoners' rights, disability rights and employment discrimination. Denver Law's Clinical Program is nationally recognized for its work in the area of prisoners' rights, in particular, the issue of solitary confinement.

5280 Magazine compiled its "Top Lawyers 2015" list based on ballots distributed to thousands of metro-Denver attorneys, followed by interviews conducted with members of the local bar. Over 300 attorneys are recognized. The only law professor to make the list, Rovner is one of eight attorneys recognized for their work in Civil Rights law. In October of 2014, she received the Edward Sherman Award, presented by the American Civil Liberties Union (ACLU) of Colorado.
