  - v. Motion – *Naomi sets forth a motion of \$100 to buy pads, tampons, and baskets to put in the bathroom. Tempest seconds. No abstentions. Unanimously passed.*

  - i. That way weekend students can benefit from the lunch talks and vice versa. Then, store them in one place?
  - ii. Andrew – we can ask student orgs to reach out to the tech department to record it?
    - 1. Kaley – need to tell the speaker that they are being recorded so that they can deny it if they want.
  - iii. Chris – DU Law has to pay for the space of recordings on the server. (DU has a number of hours for a set price w/ Panopto and then when we go over the hour limit, we have to pay more.) The resolution – there is a PT student resources page. Could create a link so that people can request to record it!
    - 1. Then, we need the presenter / student org to approve that they want to do this.
    - 2. There won’t be a set central page so people would still need to request a link.
