

Community Innovation and Equity Project

The Community Innovation and Equity Project (CIEP) of the Community Economic Development Clinic at the University of Denver Sturm College of Law is a new, semester-long transactional clinic.

CIEP students work on projects in three focus areas:

- supporting the small businesses and community organizations that strengthen the fabric of rural communities;
- advancing equity and representation in technology; and
- community education about the rights of small businesses in immigration enforcement actions.

Through this work, law students engage in project management and strategy, explore how transactional attorneys can support systemic economic development initiatives, and provide one-on-one client representation under the supervision of licensed attorneys.

CIEP is funded by a generous grant of restricted funds designated exclusively for community redevelopment legal assistance from the Colorado Lawyer Trust Account Foundation (COLTAF).
