Cannabis Specialty Externship Program Spring 2022

DESCRIPTION

The **Cannabis Specialty Externship Program** is an opportunity for students to interact with organizations, law firms, government entities, and companies working in cannabis law and intersecting areas. This program is part of the Legal Externship Program at the Sturm College of Law and will take place in the spring 2022 semester.

ELIGIBILITY

All students who have completed at least 28 credit hours of law school are eligible to participate.

COURSE CREDIT: FIELD WORK AND SEMINAR

Students will receive externship credit for a position under this program. Please contact the externship office in suite 365 and/or at externships@law.du.edu to understand how the program works, and to ensure you are aware of the deadlines and enrollment procedures. Students must have a minimum 2.3 G.P.A. to do an externship.

The fieldwork portion of the Cannabis Externship Program is pass/no pass only and can be completed for 3 or more credits. If you would like to earn more than 4 credits, please contact Leann Steele at lsteel@law.du.edu so she can schedule an appointment for you to meet with Professor Scarola. (Credits count toward the limit of 15 externship credits, which are part of the 25 available out-of-class credits). Students must complete 50 hours of field work for each credit over a minimum of 10 weeks, up to a maximum of 15 weeks.

Students must also register for a 2-credit graded Cannabis Seminar with Professor Scarola. The course will cover the insurance implications for cannabis lawyers, dive deep into hot topics in insurance law as it relates to cannabis including risk management and products liability claims, learn how to navigate the complex legal landscapes of marijuana, hemp, and CBD, and explore other related topics (tax, banking/finance, etc.) The course will be taught in conjunction with guest lecturers. APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS

All application materials will be sent to Leann Steele at lsteel@law.du.edu in the Legal Externship Office by **November 1, 2021**, and she will forward a packet of all applications to the placements by November 2. Participating placements will then select the students they want to interview and make interview arrangements directly with the student. This will give placements the opportunity to personally interview students and allow the student to interview with several different attorneys at the prospective placement. The priority deadline for students to register for the Cannabis Externship Program is November 21, 2021.

A link to the Externship Registration Form will be sent to the student once the acceptance is received.
