


## Where do you begin?




# How can local governments fight global warming?



Local government policies affect all major sources of greenhouse gas emissions.


### The 5 Milestone Process



### ICLEI and the U.S. Mayors Climate Protection Agreement (MCPA)

- As of February, 2008, over 750 U.S. cities have signed the MCPA
- Mayors strive to meet or beat the Kyoto Protocol targets: 7% reduction from 1990 levels by 2012
- Mayors urge the state and federal government to adopt environmentally sustainable policies and programs
- ICLEI members are often also MCPA signatories
