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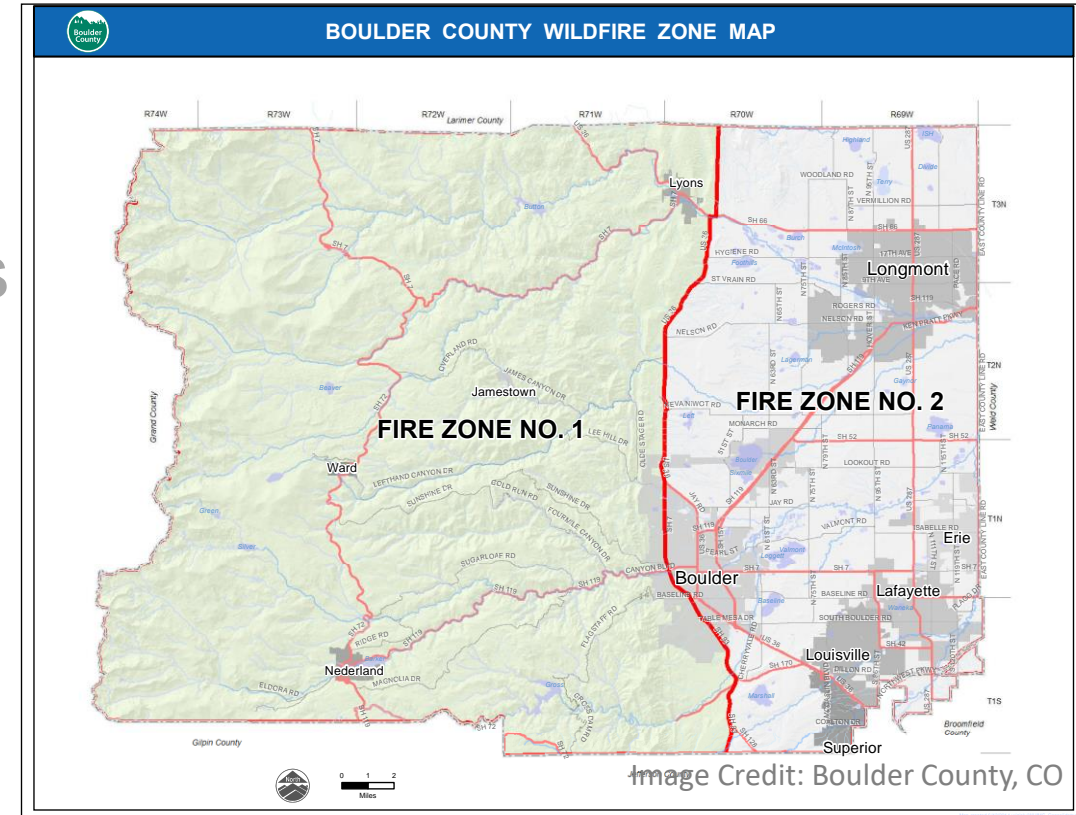

# Baseline Resilience Standards

- Know your wildfire hazard area
- Evaluate land uses
- Build with ignition-resistant materials
- Ensure water supply and access
- Manage vegetation

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# Resilience Quotient Point Options

- Conduct site assessments
- Apply to sheds, retrofits, additions, etc.
- Implement development agreements
- Adopt ordinance for firewood storage
- Require non-combustible zone

# Potential Incentives

- Prioritize areas for mitigation projects and funding
- Expedite review process or waive fees
- Offer free property assessments
- Identify insurability benefits, discounts, tax credits
- Earn recognition
