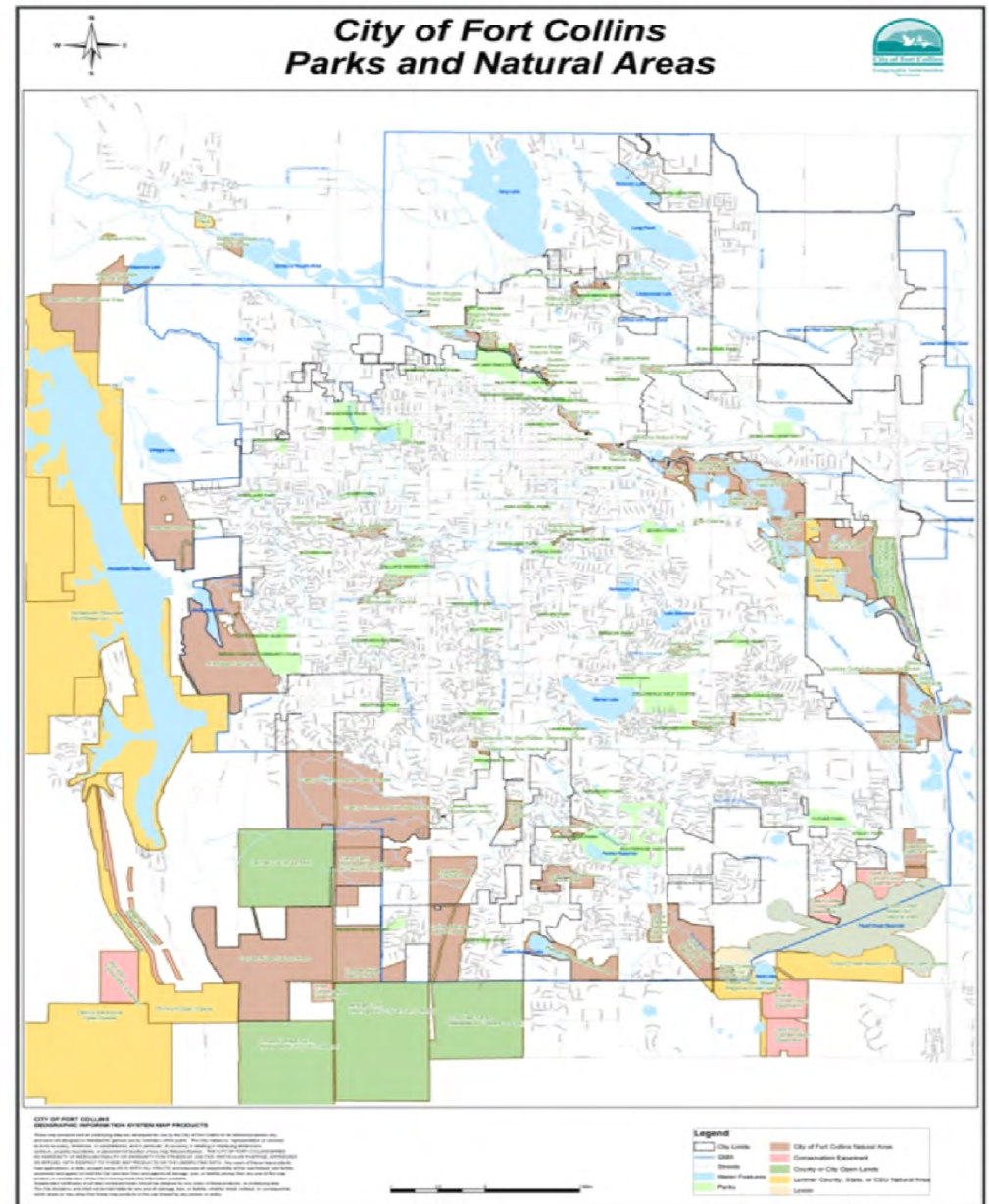


# Growth of a System – Boulder

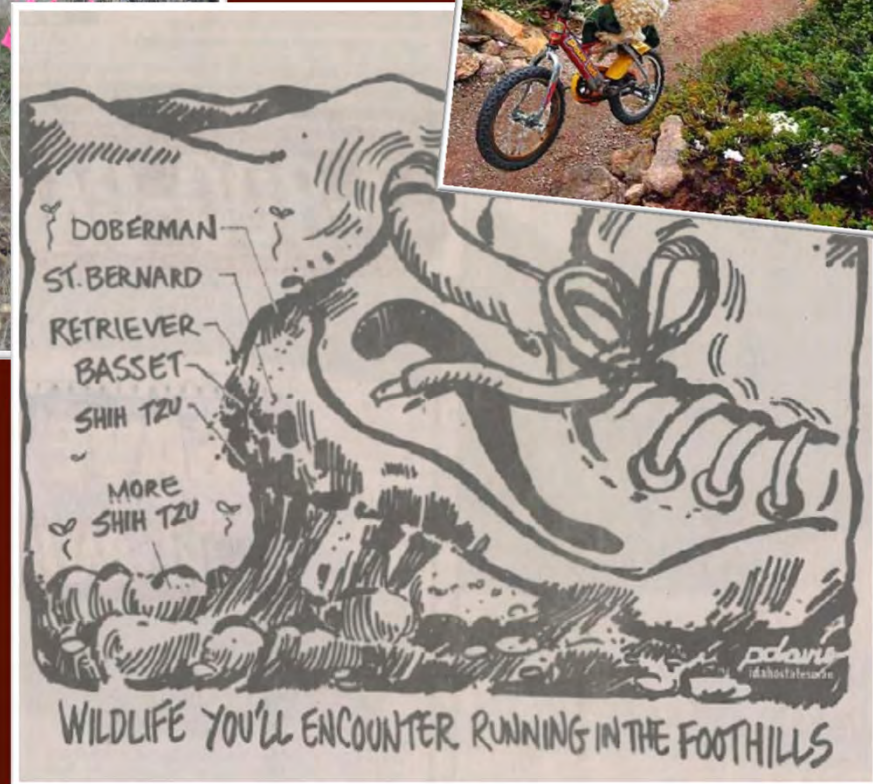
